

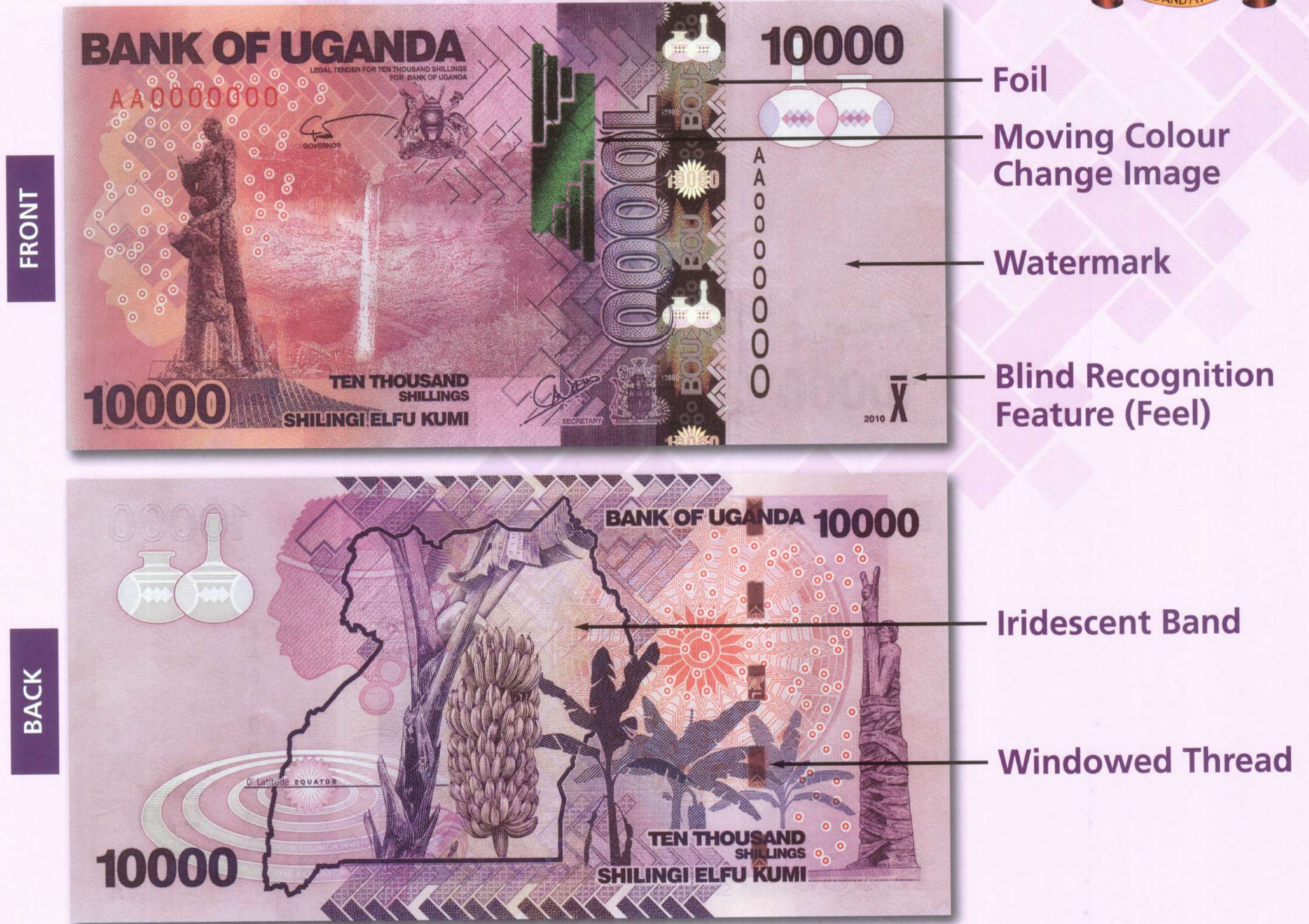


# BANK OF UGANDA

## New Family of Banknotes



Security features contained in the Shs. 10000, Shs. 20000 & Shs. 50000 banknotes



### Watermark

All notes of the new series show the same image of the crested crane. Look for the light area near the eye and the dark area above the beak. The denomination is highlighted.



### Moving Colour Change Image

The prominent green pattern contains a diagonal bright line that moves when tilted side to side.



### Foil

The foil images are distinctly different. In addition to the denomination a main pattern, shield (50000), drum (20000) and pots (10000) can be clearly seen. The edge shapes also reflect the note patterns.



### Windowed Thread

The thread changes from red to green when the note is tilted away from you. Additionally, when held to the light, the thread is continuous and includes the letters BOU with the symbol for the blind.



### Iridescent Band

Moving the note around shows a hidden shiny stripe pattern. In every banknote pattern there are the letters BOU and the denomination figure.



If in doubt, compare with a known genuine banknote
